

Call for Demonstration of Netzwerk Konkrete Solidarität [Network Concrete Solidarity] on
December, 10 2015

Though the German government praised its „Welcoming Culture“ which comes from the „hearts of the people“ and „goes around the world“ (Merkel), at the same time, refugees' homes are going up in flames and „the hardest regulations for restriction of refugees“ (Seehofer) that ever existed in Federal Republic of Germany are established. But the reality of refugees' lives is already marked by lacking right to self-determination, bleak placements and isolation. The ongoing undermining of fundamental basic rights and rigorous rhetorics diminish the hope for bettering.

On the Day of Human Rights, we want to show that we do not accept racist laws. We demand an open society and humane politics for everyone. Every person – independent of origin, cultural or religious background, gender or social status – has the right to decide about her*his place to life.

As a result, we demand save escape routes, humane living conditions and free education and patient care for everyone! Self-determination, physical and psychological well are not a privilege of a few but the right of every person. Therefore, we call for a demonstration on December, 10 2015 in Frankfurt / Main to show our rejection of racist politics. The demonstration will start at 5 p.m. in front of Frankfurt Main Station.
